

LET THE GAMES BEGIN ICE SHOW

FRIDAY, APRIL 8TH – DRESS REHEARSAL

6:00 - 9:00 PM

Please arrive no later than 5:15 to allow time to get costumes and skates on. All skaters will need to be signed in for security purposes. Volunteers and dressing room attendants must sign in as well. Volunteers will be given identification badges to allow them access into restricted areas.

UNLESS YOU ARE A VOLUNTEER, YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE CHANGE ROOM WITH YOUR CHILD!

Preschoolers and Canskaters who are only in the first half may go home at Intermission. Parents will need to sign their children out at the Security Desk.

If you wish to watch the dress rehearsal, tickets will be available to purchase at the door for the nominal cost of \$5.00. Performing skaters are free.

Hair requirements for Photo Day, Dress Rehearsal and Ice Shows:

PRESCHOOL & CANSKATE (Level 5 and below): All children in Canskate 5 and below MUST wear a helmet on the ice during the Theme run through, Dress Rehearsal, and Ice Shows (face masks at parent's discretion). For Photo day, children may wear their hair in the style of their (and their parent's) choice.

Canskate 6 (PUZZLE PIECES): High ponytail

JUNIORS, INTERMEDIATES AND SENIORS: ½ up and ½ down (hair in front is clipped back with bands or barrettes) and out of face

The following courts or features are the exceptions:

ON YOUR MARK: High ponytail

ACROBATS: High ponytail

CONTESTANTS: High ponytail

FINALISTS: High ponytail

GEM: High ponytail or her choice given quick change

MINECRAFTER: High ponytail or her choice given quick change

COWGIRL: ½ up and ½ down if possible given quick change

CONCERT: Skaters choice

Costume requirements for Photo Day, Dress Rehearsal and Ice Shows:

COSTUMES: thicker skating tights can be purchased from the office (while supplies last), or from a skating store

CANSKATE: Girls must wear regular footed tights, beige coloured. See office for appropriate colour.

STARSKATERS AND FEATURES: Girls must wear over the boot tights. No bright coloured undergarments as they may show through the costumes. Basic make up requirements: dark eye liner, red lipstick, blush and eye shadow in neutral colours (smoky eyes).
